## Yard Rules

**In order that everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience whilst at Ebbisham Farm we have felt the need to have a few ground rules.**

Approved hard hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted anywhere on the premises, it is your responsibility to ensure your instructor is aware of this.

No smoking in any buildings, anywhere on the yard, other than the car park.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and are not allowed in the stables, schools, the fields or ride.

Please check with a member of staff before using the cross-country course, riders must always be accompanied.

Yard opening times are 7.30am to 9pm on weekdays and 7.30am to 7pm on weekends; if you require access to the yard at other times please arrange it with a member of staff.

When loading horses please use the concrete area by the office not the car park.

No cars are allowed into the yard area of the stables.

Please leave tack on your pegs in the tack room and tick the board if cleaning is required.

Please dismount before entering the barns.

Horses should not be tied up in the passageway between the stables.

Horses from other yards are not allowed in the yard area, unless approved by a senior member of staff.

Horses are not allowed in the car park area.

Please do not graze horses on the mown areas around the yard, if you want to hand graze your horse please check with a senior member of staff first as to which field to use.

Staff is responsible for turning out; owners are not permitted to turn out their horses.

Please ensure that your grooming kits etc are put away in the wooden cubby holes, the floor and passageways should be kept clear at all times.

The office area, feed room and hay barn are for staff use only, if you require anything from this area please ask a member of staff.

Please ensure you have your transmitter with you when hacking out, it reduces the noise nuisance for our neighbours.

Riding School rules:

Pass left to left

Walk off the track so that riders in faster paces can safely pass on the track

Do not halt on the track

Warn other riders before entering or leaving the school

Give way to horses performing lateral work

Please remove your horse's droppings after using the schools; this will help to preserve the surface.

Jumps for the 25m x 65m school (new school) will be stored outside the school. If you use the jumps please put them away straight after use. This will allow the school to be used for dressage as well. If jumps are left in the school we will charge the offending person for the labor of tidying them away.

There will still be jumps in the 40m x 45m school and these can be left out, however please leave the outside track empty.

Please do not turn horses out, or loose school in any of the schools. Your horse can be turned out in the pen for a roll.
